JULY 8, 1965 NR 14

A reciprocal operating agreement is now in effect between the United States and Australia. Amateurs of one country visiting or residing in the other may obtain permission to operate their own amateur stations there. The United States has previously reached such agreements with Ee gium, Bolivia, Canada, Costa Rica, the Domincan Republic, Ecuador and Portugal. Many others are being negotiated and successes will be announced as they occur.
